DISCIPLINE POLICY: Trinity Lutheran School seeks to maintain an environment of love, respect, encouragement, discipline, and forgiveness. Since the teachers have the responsibility of maintaining this environment in the classrooms, each teacher will establish and communicate written and oral expectations for the behaviors and attitudes of the students in his/her class. The entire school staff will also establish and communicate expectations for the behaviors and attitudes of every student, whether they are on the school campus or a school related function. If a student does not abide by these expectations disciplinary action will be taken by a school staff member. Such discipline may take many forms; such as loss of privileges or verbal reprimands. If the student's behavior is repetitive or significantly disruptive, a parent or legal guardian will be informed and the principal may suspend the student. If the student continually disrupts the school, the principal may expel the student.

POLICY REGARDING THE RELEASE OF STUDENTS TO AUTHORIZED PERSONS: Trinity Lutheran School is concerned about the welfare of the students who attend our school. Therefore, we will not release a student to any person without written authorization from the parent or guardian (unless in an emergency situation when verbal authorization from the parent or guardian will be required)

PARENT'S INTERNET RELEASE: I understand that Trinity Lutheran School has an Internet use policy that prohibits children, and adults that use the Internet at Trinity, from accessing the web for personal use. Web sites and Web addresses that are not appropriate are monitored by the IT personnel at Trinity and individuals that do not follow this published guideline will be denied access to the Internet. Students that violate these guidelines will be placed into the school discipline plan, beginning with a one day in-school suspension. Concurrent violations during any part of the school year will result in further action within the realm of the school discipline plan and at the discretion of the school principal and the board of school ministry.

Students at Trinity Lutheran School should be aware that Trinity has policies and guidelines regarding the use of its computers and iPads.
