Theme of the week

Weekly themes are used to give children experiences to learn about and explore what they see in the world around them. Children experience these themes with hands on activities, books, songs, poems, and lessons that relate to the theme. Science and social studies are fun when children can understand and explore what is happening around them!

Letter of the week and Literacy

Literacy concepts are easily incorporated using the theme of the week as well as the letter of the week. Preschoolers are read to daily as well as having the opportunity to explore books independently. During Letter of the week time children are immersed in exploration, projects, songs, and activities that are built to make letters meaningful and memorable.

Jesus time story

Little Lambs Too is a children's ministry tool used to teach children specific stories from the Bible as well as to introduce and explore larger Christian concepts. Each week the Bible story changes and is sent home. During Jesus time children listen to the story in a variety of ways, sing Christian songs, and participate in activities to understand God's love and grace.

Math

Math is in a preschooler's everyday life. Small and large group activities, games, songs, free choice exploration and hands on activities are just some of the ways math is explored daily. Math contentment is based on Wisconsin Model Early Learning standards with added curriculum introduced.

Social Development and Independence

Academic and personal achievement can only be reached if the child has a strong comprehension of social-emotional intelligence. Throughout the year, focus is placed on formal and informal lessons containing social and emotional concepts. This journey of independence and social competency is guided by the teacher through formal lessons, concept books, modeling, and observation and assistance during real life situations.
